

CONCLUSION

The library is currently in Phase III of its reopening plan which coincides with the guidelines released by the Rhode Island Dept. of Health and Gov. Gina Raimondo's directives. Virtual services have risen to the top of the library's service model as dictated by the COVID-19 pandemic. Every first year goal of this plan is being reviewed and revised as necessary. Public meetings, workshops, digital literacy training, and programming are all on hold.
