






## **Events and Happenings at Middletown Public Library**

## **From the Director's Laptop**

I just caught up on the spring issue of Public Libraries and read that most people, including staff other than the director, don't know how the library is funded -- are you one of those people? If yes, I'm here to change that.

The MPL's FY22 budget is \$925,044 of which \$126,831 comes from RI Library Grant in Aid (GIA). These GIA funds are mandated to first pay the annual Ocean State Libraries (OSL) membership fee of \$31,699. The remainder is used to partially fund personnel and collection expenses. Each year as the membership fee goes up the amount available for staff and book purchases goes down. The remaining \$798,213 (budget-GIA) is funded by Middletown tax payers.

The budget is comprised of three categories: employee costs, library operations and capital expenditures (mostly major repairs such as last year when the air conditioning condenser failed).



The amount for each category is determined by the Library Board of Trustees and the Town Finance Department. Specifically the Finance Department calculates the amount needed for the employees' collective bargaining agreement, all other personnel costs, liability insurance, and utilities. The Trustees decide how much is needed to fund library operations. Often this process is a moving target so making it all work can be a shell game.

The Friends of the MPL (FMPL) have historically helped financially with wish list items and children's programming costs. Right now our wish list is in temporary storage because COVID has put a limit on everything. By the way, did you know that during the pandemic, 25% of RI library workers were laid off? No one was laid off in Middletown. Rather, staff completed a full inventory of the collection; provided curbside pickup; provided services virtually, by phone/email; and initiated the Middletown Reads project whereby Middletown families received free books provided by the FMPL Bookstore.

You've probably figured out by now that the services of the public library are free but making it all work for you is not free. It depends upon:

- your tax dollar
- the skill of the Library Board of Trustees to develop a sustainable budget
- the generosity of the FMPL

The biggest takeaway is: This year especially, the Middletown Town Council showed steadfast support for library services in approving the library's budget request as it was submitted. The Trustees, staff, FMPL and I are so grateful. Therefore, I'd like to ask you for two favors:



























