What to know about this kit:

This kit contains interactive books and toys that are food themed. Have fun using the finger puppet books, identifying foods and the words that match them, and playing with the food toys. We've also included songs, finger rhymes, scarves, and egg shakers to extend the fun of learning through play with your child.



What can I do with this kit?

- With the Farmer's Market Color Sorting set, you can sort the foods according to color, and practice counting how many are in each color group.
- Practice the sign language signs for "yummy" and "yucky"
- With the stacking doughnuts toy, talk about the sizes of the doughnuts. When stacked, you can then talk about the concept of top, middle, and bottom for the position of the doughnuts.
