We've also included songs, finger rhymes, scarves, and egg shakers to extend the fun of learning through play with your child.

- Read Eric Carle's "From Head to Toe" and see how many things you and your child can do, just like the animals.
- Get silly with "The Belly Button Book" and see how many times you can find your belly button.
- How many body parts can you and your child find on the plush doll together? What parts does it not have
