What to know about this kit:

This kit contains interactive books and toys that are shape themed. From stories with shapes, to books that simply identify shapes, this kit is a great learning resource for shape recognition. We've also included songs, finger rhymes, scarves, and egg shakers to extend the fun of learning through play with your child.



What can I do with this kit?

- With the shape sorting truck, you can:
- Challenge the child to stack as many shapes without toppling over
- Ask the child to identify the name and color of each shape
- Place the shapes around the play space and ask the child to “drive” around the room, picking them up and putting them into the dump truck along the way
- Ask the child to tell a story about the construction truck and what the drivers might be building with the shapes.
